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With whimsical illustrations and text, students love any title from the *Sheep in a Jeep* series. Students love seeing the antics of these crazy sheep.

Students will "recognize and produce rhyming words." --*Massachusetts English Language Arts Curriculum Framework*

Materials

- Sheep in a Jeep by Nancy Shaw
- a marker
- chart paper

Set Up and Prepare

My class used this series when the primary grades did a study of wool textiles and production.

Directions

Slowly reread the text, allowing students time to identify rhyming words. As they make the connections, use the marker to record the rhymes on the chart paper.

Lesson Extensions

Try the same lesson with any of the other titles in the Sheep in a Jeep series.

Give each student a blank sheet of paper with the text from the book.

Have them illustrate their page and compile them to create a new classroom book.
