### GROUP ACTIVITY GUIDE

After storytime, spend more time together by doing some of these fun group activities!

#### INTERACTIVE BREATHING EXERCISE

Ava and Mommy want Saturday to be perfect, but sometimes things don't go as planned. So when they're feeling overwhelmed, they both take a deep breath to calm down. Teach this special breathing exercise to your storytime group. Gather attendees and encourage kids to either face or hold hands with their parents or guardians. As a group, take a deep breath in for three seconds, and exhale with a "whoooshh" sound for three seconds. After exhaling, say together, "Today was special. Today was splendid.

Today was special because I spent it with you!"

#### SATURDAY CHARADES

Ava and Mommy zoom around town with lots of things to do. Play a fun game of charades inspired by the things they do on their Saturday! Activities you could act out could include listening to storytime, getting a new hairdo, picnicking in the park, and performing a puppet show. Encourage participants to mimic things that they do on Saturdays with their loved ones.



#### WHAT MAKES SATURDAYS SPECIAL TO YOU?


