



Be a Mini Boxitect

No cardboard boxes handy? No problem! Make a collection of cubes using this template. What can you make with them?



INSTRUCTIONS

Make as many copies of the template as you want boxes. Carefully cut along the exterior outline. If you want to decorate your box, do that before you tape it together. Fold on the orange lines with the illustrated panel becoming the outside bottom of your box. Fold up the sides, tuck the side flaps within your box, and tape to secure. The top flaps will support your box lid when you fold it down. Insert the lid flap and tape to secure. You now have a cube!
