Can a young boy find fire for his family and bring it safely home? Find out in this exciting, nearly wordless picture book adventure set in prehistoric times.

Use *Finding Fire* in your classroom to talk about the importance of fire to human civilization, bravery, ingenuity, perseverance, and friendship.



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- Consider the importance of fire in prehistoric times. Make a list of things it was used for, such as light, warmth, cooking, and protection.
- Use Finding Fire as a starting point to research life during the Paleolithic period.
- With the exception of the first page, Finding Fire is wordless. Using the concept of visual literacy, ask students to write their own text to accompany the pictures.
